Literary mirroring is evident in the immediate context. It may also be significant that this third thousandfold is arranged at a location where the context is "in (the) sea." The sea was distinguished and was named in Gen. 1:10, on the third day of creation.

"lest He [God] punish upon her!" | Identification of the verb subjects seems particularly difficult in some lines of chapter 27, as is evidenced by the variety in modern English translations. The divine Subject appears to be addressed in second person and then in third person on subsequent lines (next page). Here, it appears He addresses Himself in first person and then in third person on subsequent lines. This subject identification allows the fivefold half-set to be completed in keeping with the divine sentiment: "wrath, there is not, to Me." The emphasis changes considerably in the following literary sets of the divine Subject, which are decidedly confrontational.

These literary sets in chapter 27 are modeled in what appears to be the best fit. This is an example of how literary counting could shape the translation of the text.

"go out!" | If literary counts are accurate, the cyan dashed line represents the completion of the first 3500 literary elements in the Book of Isaiah. The imperative that follows, "go out," may correspond with the reflection of another 3500 elements going out from this point, for a stature reaching to the full measure of the age, 7000-fold. This possibility will be proven out as the literary count progresses to the end of the book, and the macrostructure will be further evaluated. The possibility of a mirrored, 7000-fold macrostructure may be established in local context:

- The divine word is spoken "from behind you." See Book of Revelation, which features a folded 3500-fold literary stature, and for which the vision is introduced similarly, Rev. 1:10-12.
- The parsing of space into right-hand and left-hand (dual directionalities).
- The turning back from paths of idolatry to the path of God: a return to fellowship with the Creator.
- The eschatological discussion that follows, which doubly emphasizes a sevenfold measure.

Observe the 40-fold mirroring about this same 3500-fold completion point. The literary mirror associates the doubled 7-fold eschatological measure (on the left, "seven of the days") with the thousandfold measure given on the previous page. In fact, Isaiah may have cleverly cued the 7000-fold measure by his placement of cardinal numbers alongside the thousandfold measure, as shown on the previous page.

If literary counts are accurate, the 4000<sup>th</sup> element in the Book of Isaiah occurs here, at the close of a major prophetic section and the transition to a narrative section. Notice the literary mirroring of "gladness" about the purple dashed line.

This mirroring point may also feature a broader 70-fold reflection. The reflection reaches upward to a 2-fold context of sufficiency in God: "one from these is not missing – a female, her fellow, they do not lack." The reflection reaches downward to a 2000-fold context of defiance against the sufficiency of God: "and I will give to you thousands (two) horses – if you are able, to set to you, (those) riding upon them!" Taken together, these values may form a correspondence – by literary device – with the 4000-fold total literary count at the present location:  $(2-fold) \times (2000-fold) = 4000-fold$ .

This thousandfold line may also serve as a bookend for another measure having thousandfold proportions: the 185,000 who will be smitten by the Angel of YHWH, 37:36. A 185-fold measure may be mirrored about the moment of Isaiah's prayer, 37:4-5. Follow the gray dashed line on the left.
